



PARTICIPANT REGISTRATION CONSENT

Newcastle SailFest “Try Sailing” Session

I/we consent to the below mentioned minor participating in the sailing activities of the Newcastle Cruising Yacht Club (herein known as “NCYC”). I/we understand that he/she will become a Junior Training Member of the NCYC for the duration of his/her involvement in the sailing activities and have his/her details recorded on the *Australian Sailing* database.

I/we acknowledge and accept that the sailing activities are a risk activity. I/we have read and understood the **Risk Warning** issued by the NCYC and I/we voluntarily assume all risks involved with the sailing activity.

I/we certify that the below mentioned participant is able to swim a minimum of 25 meters and support himself/herself in the water for a minimum of five (5) minutes without assistance. I/we further certify that the abovementioned participant is physically able to participate in the activities. I/We will ensure that the below mentioned participant will wear an approved buoyancy aid at all times whilst afloat.

I/we authorise the NCYC to obtain emergency medical assistance it considers necessary in case of injury or accident. I/we undertake to advise the NCYC of any medical condition(s) of the below mentioned participant that may affect their participation.

I/we allow the NCYC to use any photographs taken of the below mentioned participant for the purpose of promotion of sailing and the NCYC to the media and the general public, including such mediums as the NCYC website and social media sites.

In consideration of the NCYC allowing the participant to engage in the sailing activity and at my request, I/we hereby release and indemnify the NCYC and its agents, servants, invitees and members from and against all actions, claims, demands, losses, damages, costs and expenses in respect of or arising from any loss, damage, death or personal injury in respect to or arising from the sailing activities of the NCYC.

Participants are also advised that although the NCYC is covered by third party public liability insurance, this cover DOES NOT extend to participants. Any participant who considers they have a need for insurance must make their own private arrangements with an insurer.
